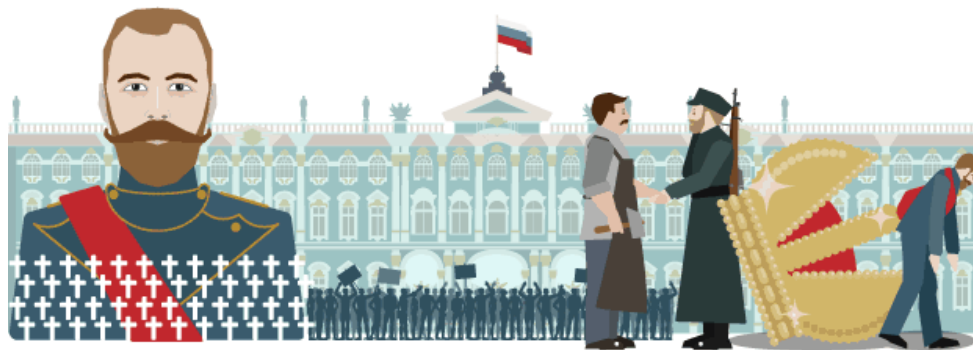

Feb/March Revolution 1917

- Key Questions:
- Why was the Tsar overthrown in March 1917?
- What were the key events of the revolution?

Winter 1916/1917

- The defeats and slaughter in the war continued
- The removal of Rasputin came too late to save the reputation of the royal family
- The winter was severe – hardly any food or fuel reached St Petersburg prices rose and people had to queue for bread
- Strikes, protests and demonstrations increased
- Support for the Tsar was disappearing amongst all social classes and amongst the soldiers
