Background

- On 30th January 1933, Hitler became Chancellor of Germany
- Later that year Hindenburg, the President of Germany, died.
- During that year Hitler had appointed important positions of power to Nazis.

Nazi Stormtroopers or SA, sometimes referred to as Brownshirts



Originally set up to 'maintain order' at Nazi meetings. This meant that they fought communists who attended their public meetings in order to disrupt them. In the early 1930s the SA fought street battles with communist paramilitaries in Berlin and other major cities.
