Functionalism		They believe in the sick role and treating people as quickly as possible to get them back to optimum functionality.
Feminism		They believe that health inequality is because of patriarchy and female oppression.
Marxism		They believe that health inequality is because of capitalism being exploitative towards the working class and poverty creating a divide in society.
Symbolic Interactionism		They believe in listening to the patient, but that too often health professionals are over-authoritative and ignore what service users have to say.
Postmodernism		They believe that we live in a society with modern technology and science which allows for fast treatment of ill people.
