★ Accessing Health Services During Lockdown

For help from a GP – use your GP surgery's online service, app, or call the surgery.

For urgent medical help – use the NHS 111 online service, or call NHS 111.

For life-threatening emergencies – call 999 for an ambulance.



Can I go to appointments during lockdown?



If you're advised to go to hospital, it's important to go. Keep going to any appointments you usually have, unless you're told not to.

Coronavirus Help

If you have symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste), use the [NHS 111 online coronavirus service](#) to find out what to do.

When to go to A&E?

Seeking medical help is one of the four reasons people can safely leave home, government guidance says.

In April A&E attendance was down by 57% since the same time last year. The was the fewest since records began in 2010. The figures have fueled concerns that thousands of people with potentially life-threatening ailments failed to seek care.

People should seek medical care when they need it and not be put off by the coronavirus epidemic. Anyone who delays seeking treatment is putting their long-term health at risk, as well as their life.
