

## **Destination's summary**


This is a summary of the routes taken by young people leaving Year 11 at the end of the 2021 academic year compared with 2019 and 2020.


# Comparisons by gender for 2021 leavers

## **Additional Needs Comparison**


Destinations of young people needing additional support as a result of a learning difficulty or disability compared with mainstream destinations of their peers not recorded to have a learning difficulty or disability.





#### **Education choices**


Of those pupils continuing in full-time education in 2021/22, here is a breakdown of the courses they have entered after completing their Year 11 studies.
