Dear Parents / Carers,

#### **RE: Year 7 Homework**

I hope that students have returned home this afternoon enthused at the end of their second week of the spring term.

I am writing to provide an update on Year 7 homework timetables. Following review of homework submission during the last half term – we have taken the decision to extend the period of time that Year 7 students will have a scaffolded homework timetable that is designed to support them in making a successful transition to their key stage 3 studies.

Homework forms a key part of the curriculum for each of our subjects. In addition, research from the EEF (Education Endowment Foundation) shows us that students completing regular homework in secondary schools can improve student's learning by 5 months, and is even more effective if students are behind in their learning.

To support students in being able to complete their homework in good time, and access ICT facilities where necessary, we run a supervised daily homework club each morning from 8 am in Room T1 (during which time students can also access our breakfast club). In addition students may utilise our homework room each lunchtime with provides access to ICT facilities.

Please see the homework timetable overleaf, this will commence from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January and remain in effect until Thursday 28th March 2024. We are confident that this will allow students to confidently and consistently meet their set homework deadlines.

Homework for Art and Music will be set in the form of extended two-week projects. These will be set on a carousel basis so that students do not have more than one extended homework project at one time.

Should students wish to complete additional learning at home – please ask them to speak directly to their classroom teacher or relevant head of department who will be able to set appropriate activities aligned to the curriculum.
