

# **Key Considerations**

### Travel to and from school

### Be organised

- Create an evening routine
- Check the timetable located in the journal
- Check the school journal for homework
- Ensure your daughter has all the correct books and equipment for that her homework is complete




### Movement around the school

- Your daughter will change classrooms up to 6 times per day.

- Ensure your daughter has a robust school bag
