Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Thorpe Park Trip

I am writing to inform you that, due to a double booking on the part of the coach company, the Year 10 trip to Thorpe Park will now take place on Wednesday 19th June rather than Friday 21st June. We apologise for any inconvenience this change of date may cause but unfortunately it was unavoidable, and we are really keen for this trip to still go ahead to reward the girls for all their hard work this year.

The price for the trip will continue to be £32 including entry to the park and coach travel. We have managed to re-book on the same week as the original date as we are hopeful that this will give the students the opportunity to enjoy the day with shorter queues at the venue as opposed to those experienced in the very last week of term when most schools decide to visit. It is pleasing to note that we have had a high number of students book onto the trip already.

A few parents have requested an extension to the deadline and because we want all of Year 10 attending, we have decided to extend the deadline until 5pm on Tuesday 30th April 2024. After this time, you will no longer be able to book a place via ScoPay and your daughter will be expected to attend school as normal on 18th June.

Friday 21st June will now revert to being a normal school day.

As usual, we will still be planning an additional day of trips on the final week of the summer term and these will be announced very soon. These will include a number of free trips to help in these economic times and will hopefully enable all students to attend.
