Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Pink Friday – 18th October 2019

The end of the first half term is drawing near and I do hope your daughter has had a positive start to the academic year.

On **Friday 18th October** we have our annual charity event 'Wear it Pink Day', which is in aid of cancer research. Your daughter has been involved in House competitions throughout this half term and students are being invited to either bake or donate a cake(s) to bring in to sell to raise money on the day. Please be aware that the cakes are being made at home and that if students buy these cakes and have allergies to certain foods, we cannot guarantee the contents.

It is a **mufti day** and your daughter needs to wear something pink. The more 'pink' your daughter looks the better! Despite being mufti day, lessons will continue as normal and all equipment including PE kit, if your daughter has a PE lesson, is expected. The contribution for the day will be **£1** and this will need to be paid online via SCOPAY by **Friday 11th October**. The wearing of mufti is optional and if your daughter chooses not to contribute £1, she will be expected to wear full school uniform.

Your daughter returns to school after the half term break on Wednesday 30th October at 8.40am and this is a normal school day. Following the October break the summer uniform will no longer be able to be worn and all students will be expected to wear a shirt and tie to school. As the winter months draw in, please can you ensure your daughter has her school jumper, as well as an appropriate dark coloured winter coat. Brentford School does not allow 'hoodies' or other jumpers in school and they will be confiscated if they are worn to school. We are, as you are aware, very proud of our uniform and students are expected to wear full Brentford uniform each day and when they are travelling to and from school.

Please can I also reinforce the rules regarding mobile phones. Phones are to be placed in school bags on arrival to school, until the end of the day and must not be used at all in school time. If a pupil's phone is confiscated on a second occasion it will be kept in school for 5 school days. Please can you reinforce this with your daughter.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding uniform, please contact your daughter's Head of Year.
