Dear Parent/Carer,

The Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) for pupils in Year 11 will start on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025. Please find attached the timetable for these examinations.

To replicate the conditions of the real GCSEs to allow your daughter to acclimatise to the exam room further, the PPEs will take place in the Curie Gym unless otherwise indicated and will be supervised by external exam invigilators. When she does not have an exam, your daughter will be in her normal lessons revising for any upcoming exams. Therefore, she should make sure she brings her books with her to use this time productively. To further aid preparations, all students have been given guidance from each subject on how best prepare.

Once the students have completed their PPEs, we will be able to use the information to help diagnose your daughter's areas for development and help her improve further. Over the years, these PPEs have helped us to prepare students to exceed their targets generally in their GCSEs.

On the day of the PPEs, it is important that all students are on time for their examinations. All students should be lined up in their tutor groups and ready to enter the Curie Gym by 8:50am for morning examinations and 1:25pm for afternoon examinations. Please note that if your daughter's afternoon exam finishes before 3pm she will be returning to her normal lessons. However, if her exam finishes after 3pm but before our 3:10 finish time then she will be dismissed from school.

Please ensure your daughter has all of the necessary equipment with her every day for her examinations. Please go through the attached "Code of Conduct in Examinations" with your daughter, and make sure that she knows what she needs to have with her.

If you have any queries or concerns about these examinations, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will be happy to speak with you. We look forward to sharing positive results from these PPEs with you soon.
