Year 11 students will begin **study leave** from **Thursday 14th May**. During their remaining time in school, they will continue to receive high-quality revision sessions to ensure they are fully prepared for their upcoming exams. In addition, targeted booster sessions will take place before both morning and afternoon examinations, providing focused support and final preparation.

Once study leave begins on 14th May, students are no longer required to attend school on a full-time basis. Instead, they should attend only for scheduled booster sessions and examinations. Attendance at these sessions is strongly encouraged, as they help consolidate learning, address any gaps, and build confidence ahead of each exam.

Please note the following important reminders for booster sessions during study leave:

- Students are expected on site only when they have a scheduled booster session or examination. They must register with the member of staff leading the session.
- Students must leave the school site immediately after their booster session or examination has finished.
- Full school uniform must be worn for all sessions and examinations.
