RE: Year 7 Assessment Week – Monday 22 June to Friday 26 June 2026

We hope you enjoyed meeting your daughter's teachers at Parents' Evening. We trust that the discussions were both positive and productive.

I am writing to inform you about Year 7 Assessment Week, which will take place from Monday 22 June to Friday 26 June 2026. The assessments will take place in classrooms and will be conducted under test conditions. These assessments help teaching staff monitor students' progress across their subjects and provide students with an opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding within a timed setting.

The assessment timetable is attached, and a copy will also be provided to all students. Your daughter should follow the timetable allocated to her tutor group.

As you will see from the timetable, there are two Mathematics assessments: one calculator paper and one non-calculator paper. There are also two Modern Foreign Languages assessments. This is because students are assessed across the four language skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking, which requires additional assessment time.

There are no formal assessments scheduled for PE, Technology, Music or PSE during Assessment Week. Assessment in these subjects is either ongoing throughout the year or completed through practical work and end-of-year performances or projects.

Please encourage your daughter to revise thoroughly for these assessments. This is an excellent opportunity for her to consolidate her learning and demonstrate her progress across the curriculum.
