Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you so much to those who attended the Year 6 Taster Lessons and Parent Information Event on Wednesday, 10th June 2026. We hope your daughter had lots of fun, started making new friends and is even more excited to be joining the Brentford School for Girls community in September. It was wonderful to see such enthusiasm and interest from both parents/carers and students. As we said during the evening, it is great to see the support of our new parents and carers and to continue to get to know you as part of our school community; we look forward to continuing this journey together.

We are delighted that your daughter is joining us in September and would like to invite her to our **Year 6 Induction Day** on **Tuesday 7th July 2026**. The day will begin at 8.50am in the main hall. Please can I ask that your daughter arrives for the day dressed in her primary school uniform as this provides each of the students the opportunity to share which school they are joining us from. We ask that your daughter arrives on the day with a pen, pencil and a bottle of water. Your daughter will enjoy a lesson experience, take part in a number of icebreaker and team building activities, have the opportunity to meet her year group, as well as experiencing a tour of the school site.

We very much look forward to seeing you and your daughter on Tuesday 7th July. If you have any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact us at school.

Finally, the next exciting event in the school calendar is the Brentford School for Girls Arts Festival on Thursday, 25th June, from 5:00 to 7:30 PM. This event promises to be an inspiring showcase of our students' incredible talents across various artistic disciplines, including music, drama, dance and visual arts. It will be a wonderful opportunity to celebrate the creativity and hard work of our students. There will also be a host of stalls on site selling local arts and crafts items.
